ACTION REQUESTED:

Selection of Civil/Site Engineering, Inc. to provide Professional Construction Engineering and Inspection (CEI) and Compliance Services for the University Boulevard at Dean Road Intersection Improvements Project, Request for Proposals, Y23-811-CC.

Further request the Board to authorize the Procurement Division to negotiate and execute a contract with a not-to-exceed budget of \$698,018.34.

The proposal was evaluated by the Procurement Committee on September 27, 2023. Commissioner Christine Moore was assigned to the Procurement Committee.

PROCUREMENT:

This contract will provide consultant services as an extension of County staff for inspection, compliance and engineering oversight during construction of the University Boulevard at Dean Road intersection improvements. This project is located in District 5.

REMARKS:

The consultant shall assist the County by providing project management and support services for construction of the University Boulevard at Dean Road intersection improvements project. The services the consultant may be asked to provide may include, but are not limited to, review and approval of plans and specifications, daily inspection services, monitoring compliance requirements in accordance with Federal Aid Contracts, coordination with contractors and stakeholders, and other tasks as may be assigned.

One proposal was received in response to this Request for Proposals (RFP). Civil/Site Engineering, Inc. is a registered disadvantaged business entity. To ensure an open and competitive process, the RFP was posted on the County's e-procurement solution. A query

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from staff to potential proposers that declined to compete on this project resulted in the following:

Unique Designs Professional Service, Inc.: Did not propose because they did not have adequate experience to perform this project.

Metric Engineering, Inc.: They did not submit a proposal because this project was not for design services.

Nadic, Inc.: Did not respond to the inquiry.

Madrid CPWG, Inc.: Did not respond to the inquiry.

The Procurement Committee evaluated the proposal in accordance with the criteria set forth in this RFP. The Procurement Committee's consensus scores are attached.
