ORDINANCE NO. 2024-02

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO COMPREHENSIVE PLANNING IN ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA; AMENDING THE ORANGE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE KNOWN THE **COMMONLY** AS **"2010-2030** COMPREHENSIVE PLAN," AS AMENDED, BY ADOPTING **SCALE** DEVELOPMENT **AMENDMENT SMALL** PURSUANT TO SECTION 163.3187, FLORIDA STATUTES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ORANGE COUNTY:

Section 1. Legislative Findings, Purpose, and Intent.

- a. Part II of Chapter 163, Florida Statutes, sets forth procedures and requirements for a local government in the State of Florida to adopt a comprehensive plan and amendments to a comprehensive plan;
- b. Orange County has complied with the applicable procedures and requirements of Part II of Chapter 163, Florida Statutes, for amending Orange County's 2010-2030 Comprehensive Plan; and
- c. On March 26, 2024, the Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing on the adoption of the proposed amendments to the Comprehensive Plan, as described in this ordinance, and decided to adopt it.
- Section 2. Authority. This ordinance is adopted in compliance with and pursuant to Part II of Chapter 163, Florida Statutes.
- Section 3. Amendment to Future Land Use Map. The Comprehensive Plan is hereby amended by amending the Future Land Use Map designation as described at Appendix "A," attached hereto and incorporated herein.

Section 4. Amendment to the Text of the Future Land Use Element. The Comprehensive Plan is hereby further amended by amending the text of the Future Land Use Element to read as follows, with underlines showing new numbers and words, and strike-throughs indicating repealed numbers and words. (Words, numbers, and letters within brackets identify the amendment number and editorial notes, and shall not be codified.)

Such policy allows for a one-time cumulative density or intensity differential of 5% based on ADT within said development program.

Section 5. Effective Dates for Ordinance and Amendments.

- (a) This ordinance shall become effective as provided by general law.
- (b) Pursuant to Section 163.3187(5)(c), Florida Statutes, the small scale development amendments adopted in this ordinance may not become effective until 31 days after adoption. However, if an amendment is challenged within 30 days after adoption, the amendment that is challenged may not become effective until the Department of Economic Opportunity or the

Administration Commission issues a final order determining that the adopted amendment is in compliance.

In accordance with Section 163.3184(12), Florida Statutes, any concurrent zoning (c) changes approved by the Board are contingent upon the related Comprehensive Plan amendment becoming effective. Aside from any such concurrent zoning changes, no development orders, development permits, or land uses dependent on this amendment may be issued or commence before the amendment has become effective.


