Approval and execution of Second Amendment to Art in the Chambers Loan and Exhibition Agreement by Orange County,

Florida and Orlando Museum of Art

Three times a year our office borrows art from various institutions and art owners that fit one of the following categories: 1) major collections in the area, 2) artists who have lived or worked in Orange County and have a national reputation, or 3) artists whose work fits a particular theme.

The Orlando Museum of Art has agreed to replace four of the works of art from the previous Art in the Chambers Exhibit with four new works of art.

SECOND AMENDMENT TO ART IN THE CHAMBERS LOAN AND EXHIBITION AGREEMENT

between
ORANGE COUNTY, FLORIDA

and

ORLANDO MUSEUM OF ART

This Second Amendment is entered into as of February 13, 2020 by and between **Orange County, Florida**, a charter county and political subdivision of the State of Florida ("County") and **Orlando Museum of Art** ("OMA"), a nonprofit organization.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Orange County Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved the "Art in the Chambers Loan Agreement" ("Agreement") between Orange County and the Orlando Museum of Art on May 21, 2019; and

WHEREAS, on October 19, 2019 the County and OMA entered into the First Amendment to the Agreement which extended the term of the Agreement until February 14, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the BCC now desires to further extend the term of the Agreement for an additional four months.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- 1. **Extension of Contract Term.** The Agreement shall remain in effect for an additional four month term commencing on February 14, 2020 and terminating on June 26, 2020.
- 2. **Artwork.** The County and OMA desire to replace four of the works of art from the Artwork listed in Attachment A of the Agreement with four new works of art as show in Attachment B, attached hereto.
- 3. **Agreement**. All other terms, conditions and obligations of the County and OMA arising from the Agreement shall remain unaltered and in full force and effect.

WHEREFORE, this Second Amendment is entered into as of the date and year written above.






Robert Indiana Golden Love, 1973 lithograph on paper; edition 47/150




