The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$16,500 from the FY 2019 Law Enforcement Trust Fund for the following purposes:

Contributions:

Wayne Densch YMCA Family Center - \$1,500. This program provides students access to education programs and the tools necessary for their academic success.

Boys & Girls Clubs of Central Florida - \$15,000. This organization provides a compelling alternative to youth crime, gang membership, drugs, and other negative influences that affect our youth today by reaching children at an early age and providing positive activities and encouragement.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$16,500 from the FY 2019 Law Enforcement Trust Fund to provide eligible contributions to Wayne Densch YMCA Family Center (\$1,500) and Boys & Girls Clubs of Central Florida (\$15,000).

The Board voted to establish spending limits of 20% for this fund for contributions. At this point in the fiscal year, contributions represent 100% of the total expenditures; however, the restriction applies to total expenditures for the year, at year-end. The Sheriff's Office has stated that they monitor their expenditures, and that they will not exceed the 20% total for contributions.

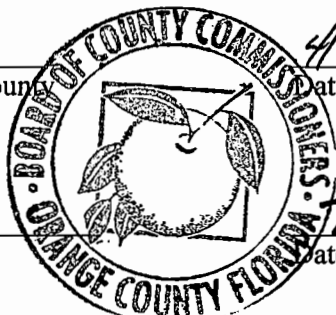

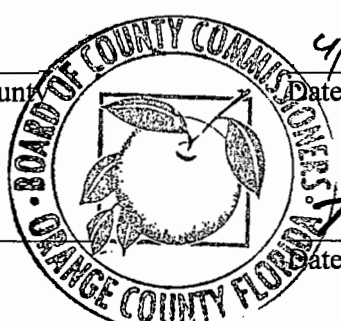
