A proposed Ordinance with Exhibit A (Legal Description Form), Exhibit B (Map), and Orlando Sentinel Notice for Ordinance No. 2021-61 entitled: An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Orlando, Florida, annexing to the corporate limits of the City Certain Land generally located north of Lake Breeze Drive, south of Rosamond Drive, west of N. Orange Blossom Trail and east of N. Lake Orlando Parkway and comprised of 7.72 acres of land, more or less; providing for severability, correction of scrivener's errors, and an effective date.
