Approval of Amendment No. 3, Contract Y19-1153, Yard Trash Grinding, with Camo Farms, Inc., in the amount of \$266,400, for a revised estimated contract amount of \$2,726,685.90.

PROCUREMENT

This amendment will fund services to handle additional quantities of yard trash at the landfill.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 4410-038-1035-3197.

APPROVALS:

The Solid Waste Division concurs with this request.

REMARKS:

On November 12, 2019, the Board authorized award of Invitation for Bids Y19-1153-AV to Camo Farms, Inc., in the estimated contract amount of \$2,340,900. This contract provides beneficial material that is utilized on the landfill for slope stabilization, cover and roadways access. As the yard waste delivered to the facility continues to increase, the demand for processing is directly impacted.

Previous contract amendment are as follows:

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- Amendment No. 1: Renewed the contract from December 2, 2022 through December 1, 2023 with a price escalation of 15.3% for an increase of \$119,385.90, for a revised estimated contract amount of \$2,460,285.90.
- Amendment No. 2: Renewed the contract from December 2, 2023, through December 1, 2024.
