





Annual Budget

Adopted FY 2019-20: \$372,877

- ▶ \$125,000 - Crime Prevention Fund
- ▶ \$222,877 - Roll Over
- ▶ \$25,000 – Contingency Fund

PINE HILLS NID

2019-20 WORK PLAN HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Create & fund economic development incentives program
- ▶ Pursue property acquisition/land banking
- ▶ Pursue capital improvements on Pine Hills Road
- ▶ Seek additional leverage opportunities and funding sources.
- ▶ Expand branding and marketing strategy to include banners and signage
- ▶ Update land use designations on Pine Hills & Silver Star Roads

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PINE HILLS NID

Recommendations:

- ✓ Enact redevelopment incentives for NID
- ✓ Support NID land acquisition/land banking goals
- ✓ Create public/private partnerships for town center redevelopment projects
- ✓ Fund recommended projects for safe, multi-modal transportation for bikers, walkers and motorists
- ✓ Allow land use updates that accommodate infill redevelopment
