  - No net differences to be reconciled
- Travel Report for June and July 2023
  - \$3,663.04: NARC Annual Meeting, NCUTCD Committee Meeting
- FY 2024 Budget Amendment #2
  - Roles FY 23 grant funds into FY 24 budget
- Personnel Committee recommendation for Executive Director's Annual Performance Review
  - Unanimous Committee opinion Mr. Huttmann and his staff continue to do an outstanding job
  - Executive Director salary increases by 10% (\$251,240 maximum contractual increase)
  - Increase of 457 Plan to \$25K annually
  - Executive Incentive Plan of 5% current base salary





- Personnel Committee recommendation for Employee Handbook changes
  - MPO staff-initiated Handbook update every two years
    - Allow employees with topped out salaries to receive a one-time payment in lieu of salary increase
    - Added two holidays to schedule; Juneteenth and Veterans Day
    - Other corrective edits
- Contribution to Bike Walk Central Florida for Best Foot Forward Program
  - \$100,000 contribution to Bike Walk Central Florida
  - Funds Best Foot Forward pedestrian and bicycle safety program over the next year







- Board Resolution in support of Blind Americans Equality Day
  - Observation of this day with appropriate ceremonies, activities, and programs to celebrate and recognize the accomplishments and contributions of blind and visually impaired Americans
- Transfer of Legal Counsel Agreement from Mateer Harbert to Dinsmore Shohl LLP
  - MPO Board approved two year with Mateer Harbert on February 8, 2023
  - The term of this agreement ends March 19, 2025
  - Dinsmore Shohl agreed to honor the rates (\$325/\$100 per hour paralegals







- FDOT Amendment to FY 2024 FY 2028 Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP) Roll Call Vote
  - Incorporates a new Complete Streets project through a \$1.2M federal discretionary Tiger grant
  - 10<sup>th</sup> Street Complete Streets Phase 1 (PD&E Phase)
- FDOT Roll-Forward Amendment to FY 2023 2028 TIP
  - Routine fiscal year-end procedure for continuous program management
  - Includes SunRail projects
- Executive Committee Recommendation on Board Apportionment (August 15, 2023)
  - Required by State and Federal Law
  - Must be submitted to FDOT by November 14, 2023









- Executive Committee Recommendation on Board Apportionment (August 15, 2023)
  - Action to approve MPO Membership Apportionment Plan
    - Includes voting seats for cities with populations greater than 50K (2020 Census) and/or two largest cities by population within the MPO Planning Area
    - Update Board voting seats for one voting seat per 150K population
    - Maintain one voting seat for the Municipal Advisory Committee
    - Maintain four voting seats for operating agencies:
      - LYNX/SunRail, CFX, GOAA and Sanford Aviation Authority
    - Two new seats: one for City of St. Cloud and one for Orange County
    - Board structure: 22 voting members and 5 non-voting advisors









Executive Committee Recommendation on Board Apportionment

#### Scenario B.2:

Update voting membership based on statutory requirements with consideration to geographic-population distribution, maintaining existing apportioned seats (1 seat / 150k pop).

- · Preserves currently apportioned voting seats
- Includes cities >50k population and/or two largest cities per county within MPA
- Adds new seats (1 each) for Orange Co. and the City of St. Cloud
- Maintains one (1) voting seat for the Municipal Advisory Committee (MAC)
- Maintains four (4) voting seats for operating agencies: LYNX, CFX, GOAA, and SFB

  - Alternate member voting
  - Board Officers and Officer Duties, Board Officer Elections, Elections
    Process and Board Officer vacancies
- Federal Certification Report
  - FHWA and FTA reviews MPO processes every four years for regulatory compliance
  - There were no corrective actions, and no recommendations to improve
  - MetroPlan Orlando, substantially meets the federal planning requirements





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
