Orange County Sheriff's Office Request

The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$22,000 from the FY 2019 Law Enforcement Trust Fund for the following purposes:

Contributions:

Children's Safety Village – \$5,000. This charitable organization is one of Orange County's essential resources for life-safety education for young children. Last year the staff served over 22,000 community residents with programs and services focused on drowning prevention, pedestrian and bike safety, gun safety, internet safety, and dangerous person awareness.

Early Learning Coalition of Orange County - \$2,000. This organization provides information to parents for child care resources, as well as the School Readiness programs and the Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten programs that provide free access to education for all eligible four-year-olds.

Boy Scouts of America, Central Florida Council - \$10,000. The Boy Scouts of America's mission is to provide at-risk youth who desperately need guidance and role models with a quality scouting program that will enable them to recognize and reach their full potential by making the right choices to accomplish their goals, to see what they can become through making the right choices, by working hard, and opening their eyes to possibilities of a more constructive lifestyle.

Mothers Against Drunk Driving, Central Florida Chapter – \$5,000. This organization educates residents living in Central Florida area about the consequences of driving drunk, educates our youth on the dangers and consequences of underage drinking, and offers comfort and support to drunk driving victims. They also provide death notification sensitivity training to law enforcement officers, coroners, and funeral home directors on how to deliver the news of drunk driving fatalities to family members.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$22,000 from the FY 2019 Law Enforcement Trust Fund to provide eligible contributions to the Children's Safety Village (\$5,000), Early Learning Coalition of Orange County (\$2,000), Boy Scouts of America, Central Florida Council (\$10,000), and Mothers Against Drunk Driving, Central Florida Chapter (\$5,000).

PLEASE NOTE: The Board voted to establish spending limits of 20% for this fund for contributions. At this point in the fiscal year, contributions represent 100% of the total expenditures; however, the restriction applies to total expenditures for the year, at year-end. The Sheriff's Office has stated that they monitor their expenditures, and that they will not exceed the 20% total for contributions.

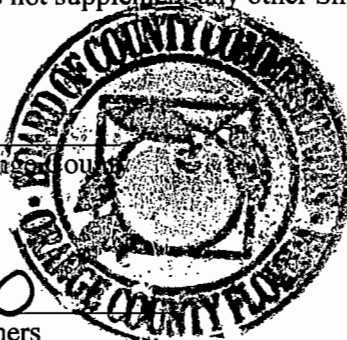

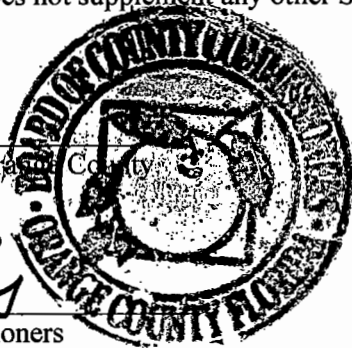

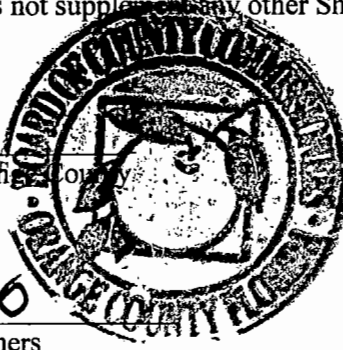
