<b>PROJECT TITLE AND EXPLANATION OF CHANGES</b> Air Pollution Control Program Support <p>This action approves additional funding in the amount of \$125,000 to Orange County Board of County Commissioners, Florida in support of their Section 105 continuing environmental program grant. The recipient will continue the development and implementation of stationary source regulations; continuing promulgation and update of enhanced mobile source regulations; improvement of emission inventories for modeling simulations; and operating a monitoring network that collects air data. Outcomes include a broadened awareness of air quality programs that are established to address the attainment and maintenance of (NAAQS) as well as immediate and emerging threats to public health and welfare from air pollution (CAA 105(a)). Intended Beneficiaries: Direct beneficiaries of this program include county residents who will have decreased exposure to criteria and hazardous air pollutants. No subawards are included in this assistance agreement. This action also approves a time extension of the budget and project period end date from 9/30/2023 to 9/30/2024 to provide the recipient additional time to achieve the goals in the work plan.</p>
