On September 18, 2018, the Board approved an estimated budget for the Children in Need of Services and Families in Need of Services (CINS/FINS) Program in the amount of \$1,728,771. However, the Florida Department of Juvenile Justice through the Florida Network has awarded CINS/FINS Residential, CINS/FINS Non-Residential, Stop Now and Plan (SNAP), and Staff Secure programs in the amount of \$1,606,712 for the period covering July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020. This represents a decrease in the budget in the amount of \$122,059.

On April 21, 2015, the Board approved an award from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency for the Orange County Air Pollution Control Program in the amount of \$60,972. Since then, nine consecutive amendments were approved, increasing the total grant award to \$1,072,650. On May 1, 2019, Orange County received a tenth amendment to increase the award by \$101,612, for a total grant award of \$1,174,262. These funds will be used for work associated with prevention and control of air pollution.
