SUBJ: **Installation of "No Parking" signs in Pine Creek Subdivision**

Citizens within the Pine Creek subdivision have expressed concerns related to the ability of emergency vehicles to access their homes when vehicles are parked on both sides of the street.

The Fire Rescue Department has confirmed that allowing parking on both sides of the street impedes emergency apparatus from accessing certain portions of the subdivision, thereby creating a public safety hazard.

Florida Fire Prevention Code, Section 18.2.3.4.1.1, requires that fire department access roads shall have an unobstructed width of no less than 20 feet. In addition, the Florida Fire Prevention Code, Section 18.2.4.1.1, states that the required width of a fire department access road shall not be obstructed in any manner, including the parking of vehicles.

The Fire Marshal recommends the Board approve the installation of "No Parking" signs for one-sided street parking on roadways within the Pine Creek subdivision to ensure safe access of emergency vehicles.

Action Requested: Approval of "No Parking" signs installation in Pine Creek Subdivision. District 5.
