On March 5, 2024, the Board accepted the U.S. Department of Transportation grant award, passed through the State of Florida Department of Transportation for the Local Agency Program for the Tiny Road Intersection Improvements at Tilden Road, awarded to the Public Works Department. The original project budget was established in two phases: construction in the amount of \$3,632,837 and construction engineering and inspection (CEI) services in the amount of \$399,746, for a total grant budget in the amount of \$4,032,583.

On November 18, 2025, the Board approved Amendment No. 1, which revised the project budget to \$3,523,437 for construction and \$320,076 for CEI services, resulting in a new total grant budget in the amount of \$3,843,513. This represents a decrease in the amount of \$189,070. The grant period is from June 24, 2024 through March 31, 2026.

This signalization project includes a new traffic signal, pavement widening for additional turn lanes, milling and resurfacing of existing traffic lanes, signing and pavement markings, curbs and gutters, new sidewalks and curb ramps, and drainage improvements.

On September 18, 2025, the Board approved an estimated budget of \$156,560 for the Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) Program. The U.S. Department of Homeland Security, through the Florida Division of Emergency Management, has awarded the grant in the amount of \$248,897; this represents an increase in the amount of \$92,337. The Board accepted the grant agreement on November 18, 2025.

This funding is used to prepare for potential threats and hazards that can affect Orange County residents, and to enhance its plans and programs as specified by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security. The grant period for this award is from October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026.
