- Adopts the latest edition of the Florida Building Codes (FBC)
- Provides consistency with Florida Statutes and Building Officials
 Association of Florida (BOAF) Model Administrative Code
- Modifies administrative provisions
- Removes redundant provisions





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- Adoption of Florida Building Code, 8th Edition
 - -Consistent with Statutory and Florida Administrative Code Requirements
 - Florida Statutes 553.73
 - Florida Administrative Code 61G20-1.001
 - Based on the 7th Edition Florida Building Code (FBC) and the 2021
 International Building Codes







- Adopt Appendix Q the construction regulations for tiny houses
- Clarifies permit expiration timelines
- Allows for inspection service/reports from 3rd parties
- Clarifies the required inspections for a pool
- Removes redundant electrical amendments









- Provide relief from permitting for small projects
 - Clarifies when a building permit is needed for small projects or when a zoning permit is required
 - No building plans review is required for small buildings that do not exceed
 120 square-foot footprint
 - Examples: tool shed, storage shed, pergola, deck, gazebo, playhouse



- Amendments to the Exterior Lighting Standards
 - -Add definitions addressing new technologies
 - -Remove outdated definitions addressing old technologies
 - Add and modify provisions to incorporate new technologies
 - Address potential conflicts with trees
 - Adjust the regulations to match Orange County's modern business operations



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- Building Codes Board of Adjustments and Appeals (BCBAA)
 - -Transmit initial draft on July 22nd, 2023
 - -BCBAA hearing on February 9th, 2024
- Local Planning Agency
 - -Verified compliance with Orange County Comprehensive Plan
 - -Hearing was held on February 15th, 2024
- Review by Industry Groups March 7th, 2024



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- Adopt the latest (8th) edition of The Florida Building Code
- Clarify administrative language
- Resident friendly approach to permit exemptions
- Update lighting standards
