COVID-19 Statistics

COVID-19 Cases in Orange County

- Over 128,000 cumulative cases
- 1,215 deaths
- 14 days' average positivity rate is approximately 6.7%
- Median age of current cases is 33

COVID-19 Testing

- Convention Center, Barnett Park
- Averaging over 3,000 tests per day
- Both sites are scheduled to remain open through April 30, 2021.



COVID-19 Statistics

COVID-19 Vaccinations

- **Currently eligible – 18+ years old (16+ for Pfizer)**
- **Over 650,000 doses administered in Orange County**
- **Over 220,000 doses administered at Orange County Convention Center site**
- **Population Vaccinated**
 - **65+ years old – 77%**
 - **40+ years old – 50%**
 - **18+ years old – 36%**



COVID-19 Statistics

COVID-19 Vaccination Initiatives

- **Orange County Convention Center**
 - 4,000 doses per day, 6 days a week
 - Transition to new site(s) in early May, 2021

- **Orange County mobile vaccination site**
 - Focusing on underserved communities
 - Barber Park – April 12-16

Emergency Rental Assistance Program

- **Total Applicants in Portal – 5,936**
- **Total Applicants Submitted – 2,640**
- **Total applications under review – 1,331**
 - **Applicants who have been contacted – 986**
- **Total Approved and Amount – 80 applications, \$328k**
- **Total Denied - *986**
 - ***Most of the denials are for duplication and/or for residents who do not qualify because they live in the City of Orlando or outside of Orange County.**



Emergency Rental Assistance Program

- **Continue to refine application and information based on analysis of data received.**
 - **Quality of applications are improving.**
- **Increasing targeted marketing to underserved communities.**
 - **Second Harvest**
 - **Community Centers**
