ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y23-739-RC, Fire Rescue Training Facility, to the low responsive and responsible bidder, Mulligan Constructors Inc., in the total contract award amount of \$38,019,365, inclusive of Additive Number 1.

In the event the bidder recommended above fails to achieve timely compliance with pre-award deliverables, as defined in the Invitation for Bids, including, but not limited to, State Division of Corporations registration, E-verify, insurance and bonds, further request authorization for the Procurement Division to award to the next low responsive and responsible bidder as listed in the bid tabulation herein, to the extent practicable and advantageous to the County.

PROCUREMENT:

The project scope of work will include the complete construction of a new commercial building, site work and various fire training props as described in the contract documents drawings and specifications. Additive Number 1 includes solar panels, mounting racks and equipment, inverters, and breakers. The project is located in District 4.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account numbers 1023-034-0727-6210 and 5896-019-0727-6210. This project is partially funded through the American Rescue Plan Act.

APPROVALS:

The Capital Projects Division and Business Development Division concur with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

Four bids were received in response to the Invitation for Bids and were evaluated for responsiveness, responsibility, and price reasonableness. The bids submitted by Interior Fusion Melbourne, LLC and The Integration Factory were deemed non-responsive for failure to provide pricing for the base bid and all requested additive/deductive bid items, or alternate bids. Both firms also failed to submit the required Bid Bond. The bid submitted from Mulligan Constructors Inc. is considered reasonable based on comparison to the engineer's estimate. References provided were satisfactory for this type of work and Mulligan Constructors Inc. has been determined to be responsible. Therefore, award is recommended to Mulligan Constructors Inc.
