Environmental Protection Commission Recommendation Request for an After-the-Fact Variance for Casey and Jennifer Deloach; Dock Construction Permit BD-18-10-105

The applicants, Casey and Jennifer Deloach, are requesting approval of an after-the-fact variance to Orange County Code, Chapter 15, Article IX, Section 15-342(e) (roof height). The project site is located at 2004 Gatlin Avenue, Orlando, Florida 32806. The Parcel ID number is 13-23-29-2964-00-671. The subject property is located on Lake Conway in District 3.

On November 20, 2018 the Environmental Protection Division (EPD) issued Dock Construction Permit BD-18-10-105 with a maximum roof height of 12 feet. On January 18, 2019 EPD received a Notice of Completion and an as-built survey showing that the dock was constructed with a roof height 13 feet above the floor elevation.

In an effort to keep the dock as constructed, the agent for the original dock permit provided a new Application for Dock Construction along with an Application for Variance to Section 15-342(e) (roof height). The affected adjacent property owner provided a written letter of support for the 13-foot roof height via email on January 22, 2019.

Pursuant to Orange County Code, Chapter 15, Article IX, EPD staff evaluated the proposed variance application and required documents. Notifications of the application for variance were sent to all shoreline owners within 300 feet of the subject property on January 30, 2019. EPD did not receive any written objections to the variance request.

During the March 27, 2019 Environmental Protection Commission (EPC) public hearing, the EPC voted to uphold the recommendation of the Environmental Protection Officer and approve the request for variance to Orange County Code, Chapter 15, Article IX, Section 15-342(e) (roof height).




