Contributions:

Autism Society of Greater Orlando (ASGO) – \$1,000. This organization advocates for individuals with autism to be afforded opportunities to become accepted, included, and active participants within our community through family support, education, and public awareness. ASGO is closely involved in Crisis Intervention Team training by offering support and instruction to law enforcement officers in dealing with autistic individuals.

Boy Scouts of America, Central Florida Council - \$17,500. The Boy Scouts of America's mission is to provide at-risk youth who desperately need guidance and role models with a quality scouting program that will enable them to recognize and reach their full potential by making the right choices to accomplish their goals, to see what they can become through making the right choices, by working hard, and opening their eyes to possibilities of a more constructive lifestyle.

Victim Service Center of Central Florida - \$5,000. This organization's mission is to provide individualized services and resources to victims of sexual assault, violent crimes, and traumatic circumstances through crisis response, advocacy, therapy, and community awareness.

Mothers Against Drunk Driving, Central Florida Chapter – \$5,000. This organization educates residents living in the Central Florida area about the consequences of driving drunk, educates our youth on the dangers and consequences of underage drinking, and offers comfort and support to drunk driving victims. They also provide death notification sensitivity training to law
