54	Section 25-148. – Tourist Development Tax Film Incentive
56	Program. The Board hereby creates a tourist development tax film incentive program pursuant to which the County may evaluate
58	requests for reimbursing eligible projects utilizing tourist development tax revenue received pursuant to this Article. The
60	purpose of the film incentive program will be to promote and advertise tourism in Orange County, Florida. The film incentive
62	program will be implemented in accordance with policies and procedures to be adopted by the Board, which policies and procedures will be consistent with Section 125 0104. Florida
64	procedures will be consistent with Section 125.0104, Florida Statutes. The Board hereby finds that the promotion of tourism via a film incentive program complies with Section 125.0104, Florida

68	Section 4. Codification. The amendments to the Orange County Code set forth in

	Section 5. Effective date. This ordinance shall become effective pursuant to general
