SUBJ: **Establishment of a Multi-Way Stop Condition at the Intersection of North Powers Drive and Indian Hill Road**

A citizen with safety concerns requested that the Traffic Engineering Division review the traffic control at the intersection of North Powers Drive and Indian Hill Road.

Traffic Engineering conducted a stop study, which entailed an evaluation of existing field conditions including critical approach speed, sight distance, traffic volumes, and crash history. In support of the results and to improve pedestrian safety, staff recommends that the existing one-way stop control at Indian Hill Road be converted to a multi-way stop control at the intersection of North Powers Drive and Indian Hill Road.

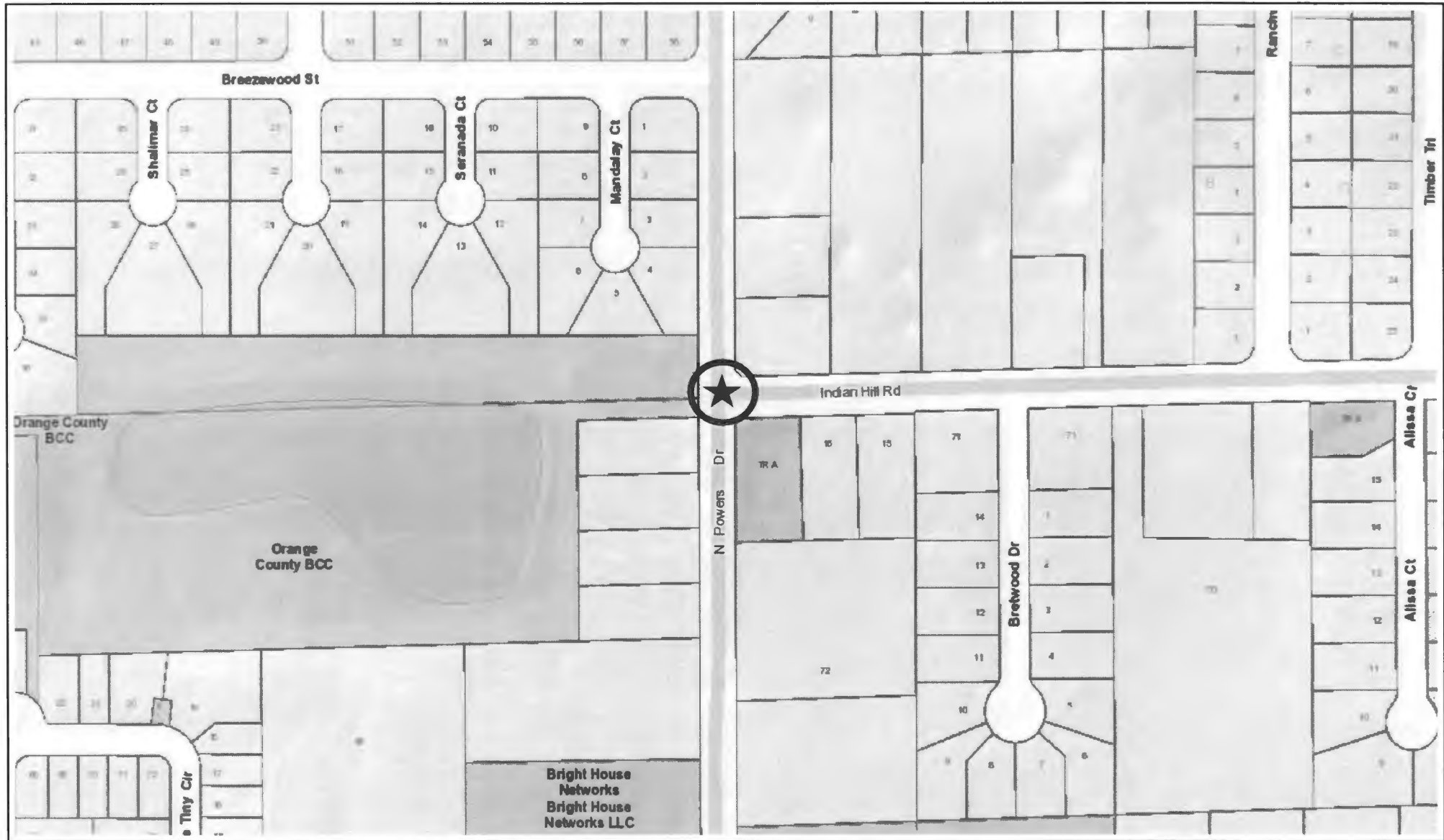
**Action Requested: Approval of a multi-way stop condition installation at the intersection of North Powers Drive and Indian Hill Road. District 2.**
