The U.S. Department of Justice (US DOJ), through the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE), has allocated \$301,278 to the entirety of Orange County for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant – Countywide (JAG-C). The Orange County Sheriff's Office submitted four projects in an application to FDLE totaling \$148,567; the remainder of the allocation went to other Police Departments within Orange County. The final two of four projects have now been awarded.

On March 7, 2023, the Board accepted from the US DOJ, through the FDLE, the JAG-C contract #8C206 for Aviation Unit Helicopter Flight Training Device in the amount of \$50,000. This funding will go towards the purchase of one helicopter training device.

On March 21, 2023, the Board accepted from the US DOJ, through the FDLE, the JAG-C contract #8C205 for Community Relations At-Risk Youth in the amount of \$33,790. This funding will reduce crime and impact community development for at-risk youth.

The total budget for both contracts is \$83,790 with a budget period from October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023.

Therefore, in accordance with Section 129.06(2)(d), Florida Statutes, it is recommended that the following accounts be adjusted by the amounts shown.
