ACTION REQUESTED:

Make a finding of consistency with the Comprehensive Plan and **ADOPT** an Ordinance repealing Chapter 31.5 of the Orange County Code ("The Orange County Sign Ordinance"), marking Chapter 31.5 as "Reserved", and providing an effective date, as recommended by the Planning and Zoning Commission (PZC) on April 23, 2025.

PROJECT: Orange County Code Chapter 31.5 Ordinance

PURPOSE: In conjunction with the adoption consideration of a separate Ordinance to create a new Orange County Code Chapter 40 entitled the "Orange Code for Orange County, Florida" with the short title of "Orange Code", the purpose of this related Ordinance is to reconcile existing County Code Chapter 31.5 (Orange County Sign Ordinance) with the proposed Chapter 40 (Orange Code). More specifically, this Ordinance would repeal existing Chapter 31.5 and mark it as "Reserved". In turn, new sign regulations have been included in Chapter 40 (Orange Code), Article III, Division 6 ("Signs"). On April 23, 2025, the Planning and Zoning Commission (PZC) made a finding of consistency with the Comprehensive Plan and unanimously voted to recommend **APPROVAL** of the Ordinance to the Board of County Commissioners.
