This memo aims to confirm my managerial appointments of Martis Mack as the Division Chief of Operations and Kimberly Buffkin as the Division Chief of Planning & Technical Services for the Fire Rescue Department.

Operations Division

The Operations Division supervises nearly 1300 certified firefighters, paramedics, and emergency medical technicians, managing emergency and non-emergency duties. They are responsible for responding to fire suppression, medical, hazmat, and technical rescue incidents. The Division Chief of Operations provides policy oversight to firefighters stationed at 44 fire station locations across seven battalions.

Chief Mack has been a part of Orange County Fire Rescue for almost 19 years. He has taken on various positions and worked up to the rank of Assistant Chief, Shift Commander, in 2020. For the past year, he has been serving as the Acting Division Chief of Operations. In addition to his operational duties, he has played a vital role in contributions to Recruit Training, Command School, and Response Coordination for the UCF Football Stadium Fire Response Program. Most recently, he spearheaded planning a 2023 Full-Scale Multi-Discipline Active Shooter Exercise.

Chief Mack graduated Magna Cum Laude from Columbia Southern University with a bachelor of science degree in Occupational Safety and Health/Fire Science.

Planning & Technical Services Division

The Planning Division is crucial in managing data that help the department make informed decisions about growth and planning compliance, including Accreditation and Public Protection Classification – ISO Rating. The division also oversees the administrative direction of the Office of the Fire Marshal. It serves as the department consultant on matters concerning the configuration of the 9-1-1 communications-aided- dispatch system.

Chief Buffkin has been a dedicated member of Orange County Fire Rescue for more than 20 years. She has held various positions, progressing to the role of Assistant Chief, Shift Commander, in 2020.
