ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval to award Invitation for Bids Y19-1135-PD, Supplemental Carbon for Eastern Regional Water Reclamation Facility, to the low responsive and responsible bidder, Environmental Operating Solutions, Inc., in the estimated contract award amount of \$572,000 for a 1-year term. Further request authorization for the Procurement Division to renew the contract for four additional 1-year terms.

PROCUREMENT:

This contract will provide supplemental carbon to aid in biological denitrification at the Eastern Regional Water Reclamation Facility.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 4420-038-1355-4170.

APPROVALS:

The Water Reclamation Division and the Business Development Division concur with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

Two bids were received and evaluated for responsiveness, responsibility, and price reasonableness. Environmental Operating Solutions, Inc. is the lowest responsive, responsible bidder. The bid is considered reasonable based on comparison to prior similar contracts.
