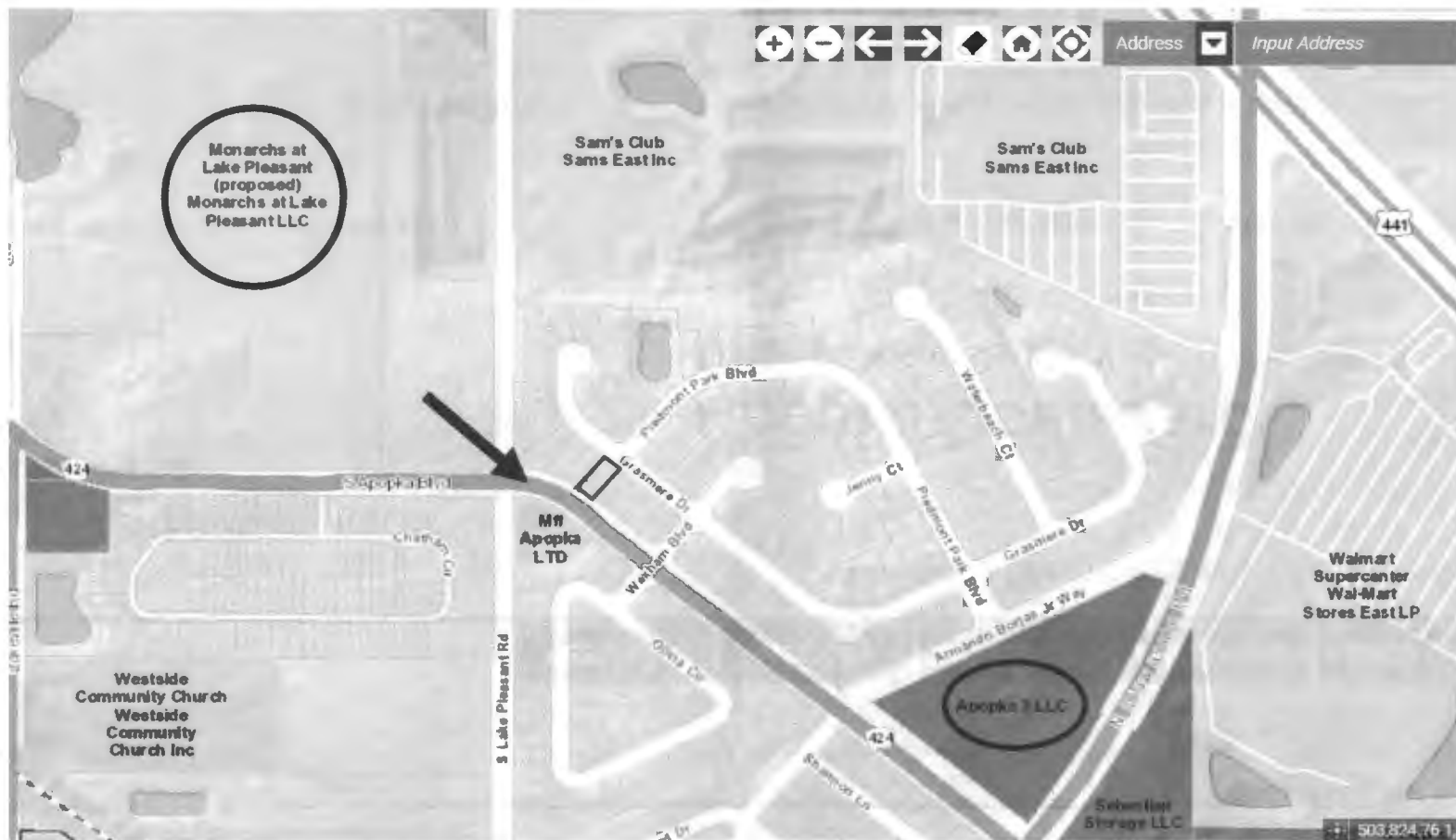

- 4 crashes in the past 12 months alone
- Residents on Grasmere Drive are scared to use their backyards because they never know when a car could crash thru the wall at the back of their property.
- One homeowner stated that he always wanted to put a swimming pool in but was too afraid to let his kids swim because the potential of a car crashing thru the wall.
- Many times the vehicles are traveling over 55 mph.
- With the addition of 125 new apartments, with potentially over 100 new vehicles on Apopka Blvd, the situation will only get worse
- When the driver is not caught or does not have insurance, our HOA has to pay to have the damage repaired.
