- National Construction and Consultant LLC is a, Minority/Woman/ Owned Company, A State and County Certified Disabled Veteran Owned Business and I am a State Licensed General Contractor.
- On (1 November 2023) National Construction and Consultant LLC was identified as the lowest bidder for this project at \$783,856.43 and the project was awarded to a firm at \$1,100,630.90.
   This award amount is \$300,000 over the Orange Counties Estimated Costs of \$785,928.14.
- 3. On (14 March 2024) I was deemed Non-Responsive for (Non-Conforming Licensure) And Removed from The Low Bid List.
- 4. I NEVER received notification from Orange County Procurement or Rolando Melo via mail, email, or phone that there was a missing document with my bid.
- 5. I should have had the opportunity to correct that deficiency.
- 6. This was an unfair act by that department.
- 7. Again (I was never notified).
- 8. National Construction and Consultant has done projects for Orange County for more than 3 years without any issues.
- 9. I emailed (Supervisor) Mr. Melo on (12 January 2024) and he replied by saying "The bids are still under the evaluation process" "If we need anything we will reach out to you".
- 10. I assumed that there was nothing wrong with my bid.
- 11. I don't think the procurement department did their "Do Diligence" To save the County Money. They never contacted the low bidder to request anything.
- 12. I would like you to investigate what transpired and award me this contract.

#### FINAL: QUESTIONS THAT NEEDS TO BE ANSWERED:

- A. Why was National Construction and Consultant removed from the low bid list?
- B. At what time did Orange County Procurement notice that 1 document was missing?
- C. Did Orange County ever reach out to National Construction for missing information? If so, by what means.
- D. Does Orange County Procurement Office have any records showing that they tried to reach out to National Construction for missing information?
- E. How can Orange County Procurement justify paying another vendor \$300,000 more than the lowest vendor to do the exact some job?





Stage Door II, Inc. as deemed non-responsive by the Procurement Division, based on the analysis provided by the Business Development Division, which identified that the M/WBE participation goal was not achieved, and sufficient good faith effort documentation was not provided. Price calculation errors by Schuller Contractors Incorporated are corrected as shown.
