

 Majority of funding is savings from changes to the FRS law



- Fire Station 84
 - Groundbreaking held on April 17, 2012
 - Exterior masonry walls are complete



Completion January 2013





- Holden Heights Community Center \$4.4M
 - Funding combination of OBT CRA, CDBG and County funds
 - Construct 13,000 SF Community Service Center
 - On Lake June east of SOBT
 - Space for multiple community based programs






- Holden Heights Community Center

Environmental Projects


- Back To Nature Wildlife Refuge \$199k

 - Planning to open new site in 2013








