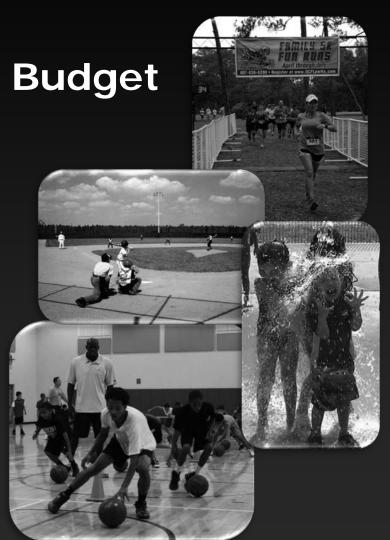

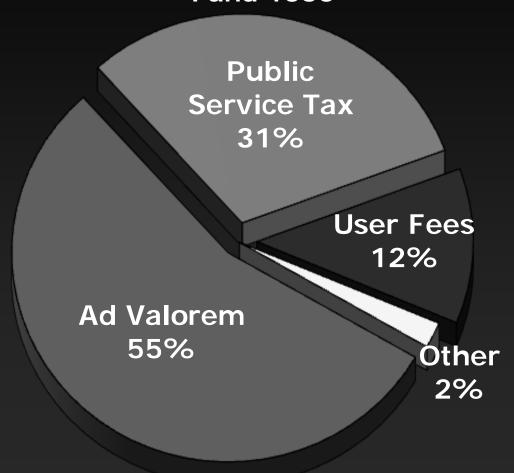

Parks Ad Valorem





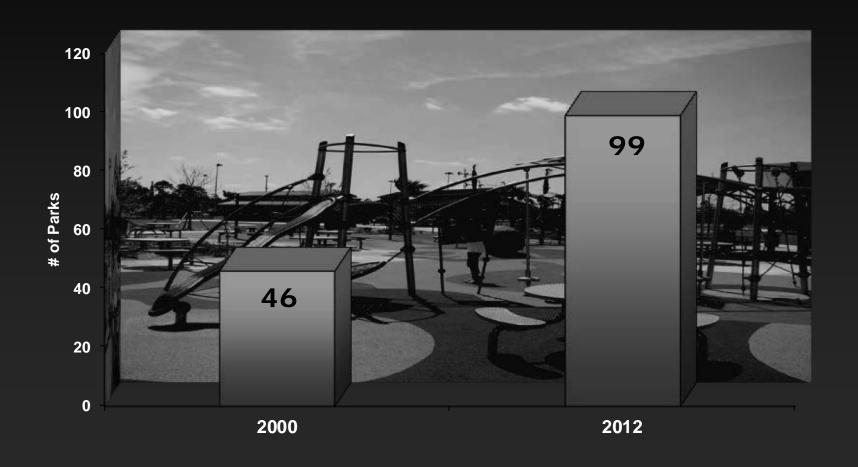

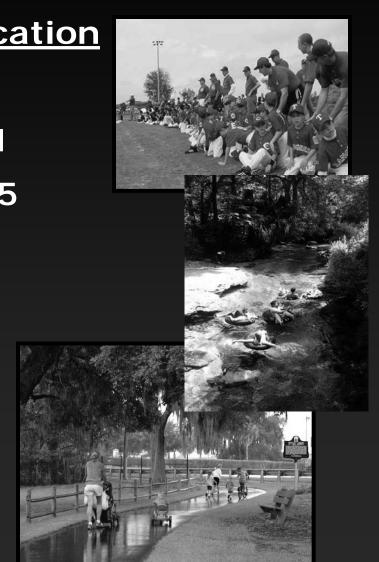




Number of Parks by Classification

Current CIP Projects

- Bithlo Splash Pad
 - Design and bid process completed
 - Estimated completion November 2012
- SR 50 Boat Ramp (Florida Boating Improvement Program Funding)
 - Renovating and improving boat ramp for ADA accessible and parking lot
 - Design completed/Bid process underway
 - Estimated completion August 2013







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Parks CIP Issues

- No new projects
- Park impact funds for land banking only
- Focused on maintaining existing facilities







Parks O&M Reductions

- Critical repairs and replacement of equipment
- Delay replacement of site furnishings and amenities
- Continue with reduction of level of service for recreation programs



Parks O&M Issues

- Increasing attendance
- Increasing demand for services
- Aging facilities
- Recurring costs for gyms/recreation centers and parks

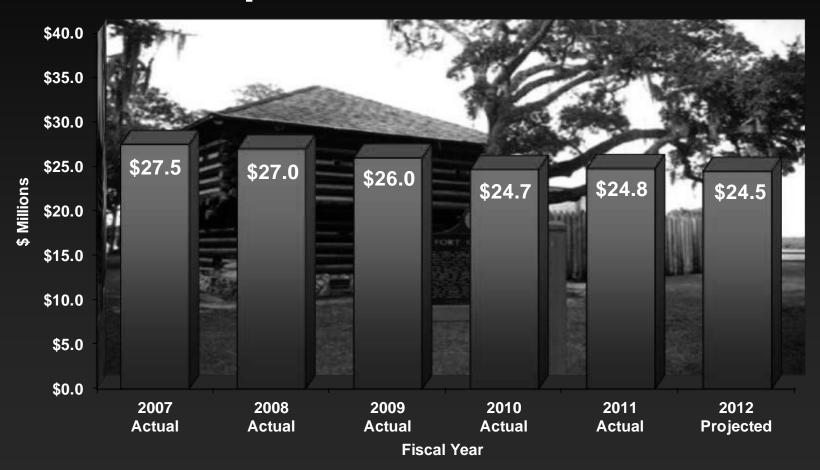






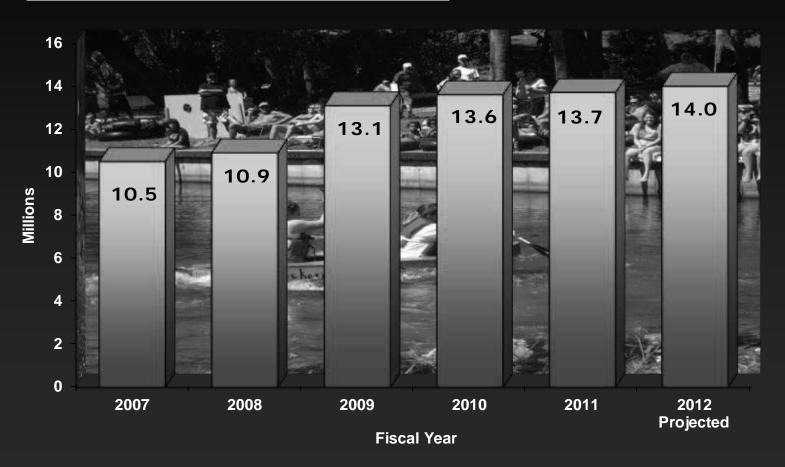


Parks Expenditures



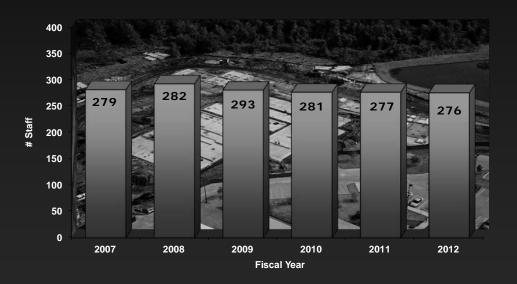
