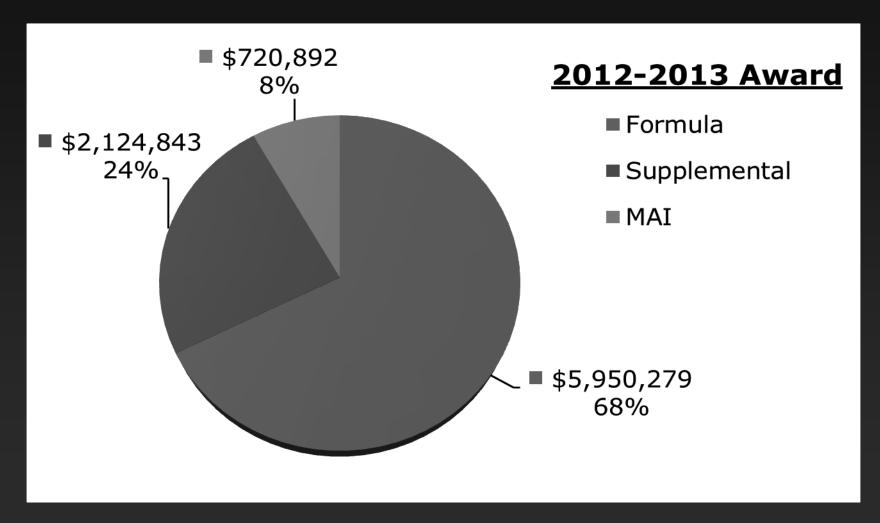
#### Overview

- Serves Orange, Osceola, Seminole & Lake counties
- Assists more than 4500 persons under or uninsured annually
- Acts as the Payor of Last Resort for expensive HIV medical care, prescriptions and many support services
- Contracts with 14 service providers

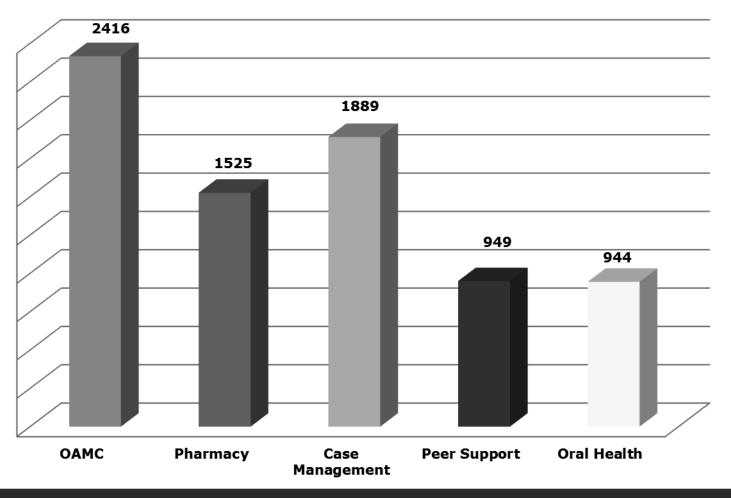
