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Chief Judge's request Operating Improvements





- During July Work Sessions Chief Judge requested an additional large courtroom
 - Required to deal with the multiparty civil suits
 - Required for high profile criminal

cases







 Additional Large Courtroom

 Looked at leasing in Fairwinds Building



- Two existing Federal Courtrooms
 - Would require construction of jury boxes
 - Would require construction of security doors
 - Would require ongoing funding for security and rent

• Annual Costs – \$700,000



- Additional Large Courtroom

 Looked at Building a Courtroom
 on 14th floor
 - Complete build out
 - Full courtroom with:
 - Elevator lobby, restrooms, jury deliberation room, inmate holding, public waiting area

• Cost

- Class A finishes cost \$2.2M
- Class C finishes cost \$1.6M





- Additional Large Courtroom

 Looked at Building a Courtroom
 on 14th floor
 - Bare minimum build out
 - No ceiling, painting, or lobby finishes
 - Install 2 restrooms and a drinking fountain
 - Cost \$250,000

– Chose Bare Minimum Option

Operating Improvements

- Hours of operation
 - -Opening building at 7:00 A.M. instead of 7:30 A.M.
 - Significantly reduced backlog at screening lines and elevators
 - Improved movement within building



Operating Improvements

- Upgrading Elevators
 - Destination dispatch
 - After initial issues, working well now
 - Completed in April/May timeframe
- Added more security screening lines



Operating Improvements

- Modify the Information Desk to improve access to the elevators
- Improved signage
- Upgrade escalators next fiscal year
- Considering obtaining a space use study for the building



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
