   UCF where several students have been killed.
- Tourist Development Taxes are wasted on venues that are not needed.
   Transportation infrastructure and Mass-Transit should have a higher priority. You need to be a leader for change in the use of these tax dollars. I have no doubt the majority of Orange County taxpayers believe traffic gridlock and mass-transit need to be addressed ahead of building new venues that can be provided by the public sector.
- Orange County Residents already pay excessive and regressive transportation taxes via the toll roads. With the exception of I-4, Orange County has no fully accessible expressways. The toll taxes are excessive and regressive. I encourage ALL FLORIDIANS TO SIGN THE PETITION THAT GIVES US THE RIGHT TO VOTE ON TOLL TAXES!
- Direct funds towards viable solutions for Mass-Transit. 1) Create a bus-hub system that would make it possible for people to use mass-transit over the personal automobile. SunRail is useless without an effective bus system. Shutdown SunRail and fix Lynx. First things first.
