SUBJ: Establishment of a Multi-Way Stop Condition at Intersection of Anderson Road and Hurd Avenue

A citizen with safety concerns requested that the Traffic Engineering Division review the traffic control at the intersection of Anderson Road and Hurd Avenue.

Traffic Engineering conducted an evaluation of existing conditions including sight distance, traffic volumes, pedestrian volumes, and crash history. Based on the findings, staff recommends that the existing two-way stop control be converted to a multi-way stop control at the intersection of Anderson Road and Hurd Avenue.

Staff recommends that the Board approve the establishment of a multi-way stop condition at Anderson Road and Hurd Avenue.

Action Requested: Approval of a multi-way stop installation at Anderson Road and Hurd Avenue. District 3.
