SUBJ: Approval to Decrease the Speed Limit on Binion Road

A concerned citizen has requested Orange County to review the posted speed along Binion Road between Ocoee Apopka Road and Lust Road. The posted speed limit on this section is 55 mph. The citizen has safety concerns that the posted speed limit is too high along this segment.

The Florida Department of Transportation uses a Context Classification Guide when determining target speed. Target speed is the highest speed at which vehicles should operate on a thoroughfare in a specific context, consistent with the level of multi-modal activity generated by adjacent land uses, providing both mobility and a supportive environment for vehicles, pedestrians, bicycles, and public transit users. This corridor is classified as a C3R-Suburban Residential with a target speed range between 30 mph and 55 mph.

The current and future density and the roadside development, in terms of the number of driveways and access points, have changed in recent years due to new developments. The pedestrian and bicycle level activities have also increased with time. Therefore, it is recommended to decrease the posted speed limit along Binion Road between Ocoee Apopka Road and Lust Road from 55 mph to 45 mph.

Action Requested: Approval to decrease the speed limit on Binion Road between

Ocoee Apopka Road and Lust Road from 55 mph to 45 mph.


