

Orange County Parks and Recreation Division 4801 West Colonial Drive Orlando, FL 32808



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December 2013, Board gave direction to develop 14 multi-purpose fields at six **locations throughout the County** Previously, field use agreements based on long-standing tradition of partnerships developed in each local community

Due to the future fields, Board directed staff to develop field allocation process





Goals of Multi-Purpose Field Allocation Process

- -Maximize field usage by youth leagues
- -Adjust field rental fees
- -Develop minimum eligibility criteria
- -Point rankings determine partners





 Parks Advisory Board convened 11 times
 Two public meetings in July and October 2014
 November 13, 2014, the Parks Advisory Board approved the Multi-Purpose Field Allocation Procedures



January 27, 2015, Board approved Multi-Purpose Field Allocation Procedures and Authorized the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board to make future changes





Minimum Eligibility Criteria

- Be an organized youth sport group that is sanctioned and governed by a recognized regional, state or local body
- Provide athletic programs to a specific service area in close proximity to requested playing fields



Minimum Eligibility Criteria

- Must run programs in such a manner that its activities are open to all persons who wish to participate, regardless of race, gender, national origin or disability
- Organized Youth Sport Group whose general membership is not based exclusively on ability and performance through a "try out" system and who do not reserve the right to "cut" players from teams



Minimum Eligibility Criteria

- Organization shall be composed of at least 75% Orange County Residents
- Organized Youth Sport Group must operate as a non-profit corporation
- The Organized Youth Sports Group must provide a scholarship program for underprivileged youth



Application Process

Point rankings determine Youth Sports Partners

- -Seven criteria are scored
- -Score up to 85 points




Application Process

Field Inventory 2014 - 16 Multi-Purpose Gridiron Sports Fields 2021 - 31 fields



























Others

- City of Orlando: RFP, RFB, & Grandfather in
- City of Altamonte Springs: (Diamond Sports Only) Fields used for internal programs only
- City of Kissimmee: No long-term rental agreements permitted, Rentals are first-come, first-served



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- Retain current Multi-Purpose Field Allocation Procedures and partners
- Conduct stakeholder meetings (Jan./Feb.)
- Reevaluate procedures based upon findings
- Continue to meet with PAB to update current guidelines
- Follow-up with Board in April with recommendations
