

On November 8, 2021 the Orlando City Council will consider proposed ordinance #2021-69, entitled AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORLANDO, FLORIDA, ANNEXING TO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY CERTAIN LAND GENERALLY LOCATED NORTH OF THE NOVEL NONA PLANNED DEVELOPMENT, EAST OF NARCOOSSEE ROAD, SOUTH OF KIRBY SMITH ROAD, AND WEST OF LAKE WHIPPOORWILL AND COMPRISED OF 24.7 ACRES OF LAND, MORE OR LESS; AMENDING THE CITY'S GROWTH MANAGEMENT PLAN TO DESIGNATE THE PROPERTY AS URBAN VILLAGE, IN PART AND CONSERVATION, IN PART; AMENDING THE CITY'S GROWTH MANAGEMENT PLAN TO CREATE FUTURE LAND USE SUBAREA POLICY S.40.12; DESIGNATING THE PROPERTY AS PLANNED DEVELOPMENT ON THE CITY'S OFFICIAL ZONING MAPS; PROVIDING A SITE PLAN AND SPECIAL LAND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS FOR THE PLANNED DEVELOPMENT; PROVIDING FOR CONSENT TO THE MUNICIPAL SERVICES TAXING UNIT FOR LAKE WHIPPOORWILL; PROVIDING FOR AMENDMENT OF THE CITY'S OFFICIAL FUTURE LAND USE AND ZONING MAPS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, CORRECTION OF SCRIVENER'S ERRORS, PERMIT DISCLAIMER AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
