SUBJ: Establishment of a Multi-Way Stop Condition at Intersection of Seidel Road at Summerlake Groves Street

Traffic Engineering staff recommends conversion of the existing traffic control of Seidel Road at Summerlake Groves Street from a side street stop control to a multi-way stop control intersection.

Orange County Public Schools (OCPS) is opening a new school in August of 2022, currently known as Panther Lake Elementary School (Site 114), located at 10151 Summerlake Groves Street. The proposed elementary school will have 837 students. A traffic signal is currently under construction and due to supply chain constraints will not be in operation before the school year starts in August of 2022.

In an effort to address traffic operations and safety, staff recommends the installation of multi-way stop control be implemented for the Seidel Road and Summerlake Groves Street intersection. This multi-way stop control will assist with the safety of crossing student pedestrians and relieve the traffic for the new elementary school with an opening date of August 2022.


Staff recommends that the Board approve the establishment of a multi-way stop condition at Seidel Road at Summerlake Groves Street intersection.
