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SUBJECT: Approval of Amendment No. 1, Contract Y21-2002, Provision of Community Services and Facility Use

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval of Amendment No. 1, Contract Y21-2002, Provision of Community Services and Facility Use, with Aspire Health Partners, Inc., in the amount of \$105,745.08, for a revised estimated contract amount of \$683,215.79.

PROCUREMENT:

This amendment will renew the contract for the period of October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023 and includes a budget approved increase and funding for the areas of counseling and case management. The following locations are added to the contract: 8301 E. Colonial Drive and 18510 Madison Avenue.

FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 0001-062-2556-8610.

APPROVALS:

The Citizens' Commission for Children Division concurs with this recommendation.

REMARKS:

On August 10, 2021, the Board authorized award of Contract Y21-2002 to Aspire Health Partners, Inc., in the amount of \$577,470.71. Aspire Health Partners, Inc. is currently providing satisfactory services under this contract as follows:

- 1. Assist adult males, 18 years and older, who are dependent on illegal substances and have demonstrated an inability to remain drug free in a non-structured environment.
- 2. Assist females, 18 years and older, with emphasis on pregnant and postpartum women with infants, who display a dependence on illegal substances and have demonstrated an inability to remain drug fee in a non-structured environment.

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- Provides Case Management, supports the Winter Park Neighborhood Center for Families: providing outreach, referrals and engagement in activities, assess client needs, and locates resources to guide the client to self-sufficiency.
- 4. Provides Family Counseling, supports the Bithlo/Christmas Neighborhood Center for Families: provides counseling to individuals and groups, families dealing with mental health and social service issues, with emphasis on prevention and achieving healthy functioning.
- 5. Provides Family Counseling, supports the Ivey Lane Neighborhood Center for Families: assisting individuals, groups and families dealing with mental health and social service issues, with emphasis on prevention and achieving healthy functioning.
