SUBJECT: Approval of Purchase Order M108658, MoV Pharmacy Migration

### ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval of Purchase Order M108658, MoV Pharmacy Migration, with BDM Healthware, Inc., in the total amount of \$193,094.70.

### PROCUREMENT:

This purchase order will provide an upgrade and annual software maintenance to the pharmacy software at the Medical Clinic and Corrections Health Services. The performance period for this purchase order is October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023.

### FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 5896-019-8655-3192.

### APPROVALS:

The Health Services Department concurs with this recommendation.

### DISCUSSION:

This purchase order will provide additional functionality to allow the Corrections Health Services to bill the State's Aids Drugs Assistance Program for HIV medications.

This is an upgrade to the existing pharmacy software at Corrections Health Services and the Medical Clinic. Since the software is proprietary no other company can perform the upgrade and maintenance. Without this upgrade, the current version of this system will not function past 2025.

Price reasonableness was established by conducting a comparison between the rates of Contracts Y15-152 Pharmacy Application Licensing Support and Upgrades and Y14-612 Corrections Pharmacy System. It was determined that the upgrade will represent a savings of approximately \$1,000,000 to the County. Once the upgrade is completed, the annual maintenance fee will be reduced from \$76,906.06 as stated in Contract Y15-152 to \$61,645.20. In 2014, a comparable upgrade was done to the Corrections Pharmacy system under Contract Y14-612.
