On September 24, 2021, the Board approved an estimated budget for the HIV Emergency Relief Project Grant in the amount of \$10,467,887. On March 8, 2022, the Board then approved the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services grant, awarded to the Health Services Department in the amount of \$11,121,097. In addition, the grant project expects to receive an estimated program income amount of \$50,000. This brings the total current grant budget to \$11,171,097, which represents an increase of \$703,210. The budget period for this award is March 1, 2022 through February 28, 2023.

The Ryan White Part A Program provides health and support services for people with the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) living in Orange, Osceola, Seminole, and Lake counties. Funding is utilized for core and support services consisting of medical and dental care, nutritional supplements, insurance co-pay and premium payments, medical case management, pharmaceutical drug reimbursement, mental health counseling, and substance abuse treatment. Food, transportation, and psychosocial support services complement the program as support components.

On September 24, 2021, the Board approved an estimated budget for the Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten Program in the amount of \$1,318,693. The State of Florida Agency for Workforce Innovation Division, through the Office of the Early Learning Coalition, has awarded the Head Start Division, the Voluntary Pre-Kindergarten Program grant in the amount of \$1,414,800, representing an increase of \$96,107. The grant budget period is from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023.

Funding from this grant will be used to provide eligible children one school year (540 instructional hours) and/or one summer program (300 instructional hours) of curriculum, to prepare them to be ready for kindergarten.

On February 11, 2020, the Board accepted the initial award from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency for the Orange County Air Pollution Control Program - EPA 105 in the amount of \$75,000. Since then, four amendments have been approved totaling an additional \$496,794, bringing the total award amount to \$571,794. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has now awarded amendment no. 5 in the amount of \$142,698, increasing the award total to \$714,492.

The Environmental Protection Division will utilize awarded funds for Air Quality Management Programs such as air permitting, compliance inspections, and ambient air monitoring. This grant coincides with the specific operating agreement between Orange County and the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, which defines the scope of services necessary for a local air program designation. The grant period for this award is October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2023.

On March 9, 2021, the Board approved the umbrella agreement between the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) and Orange County, which includes the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) funding received from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (US DHHS). Since then, the Board has approved the Notice of Funding Availability (NFA) no. 039779 under said agreement in the amount of \$4,380,387 and NFA no. 040229 in the amount of \$5,182,486, for a total budget of \$9,562,873. The US DHHS, passed through the DEO, has now awarded an amendment to add NFA no. 041228 in the amount of \$5,574,693. Once the DEO provides full release of the awarded amount, the total program budget will be \$15,137,566.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the LIHEAP program has seen an enormous impact of intake and applications to process. To alleviate an interruption in services, the Community Action Division is budgeting \$1,000,000 of the awarded NFA no. 041228 to continue serving the Orange County community.

With this funding the Community Action Division will be able to assist lowincome families and individuals at or below 150% of the Federal Poverty Level with past due energy bills. The grant period for this agreement is October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2023.

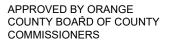
