Orange County Sheriff's Office Request

The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$329,999.95 from the FY 2022 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-Federal Forfeitures for the following purposes:

Equipment:

L3 Harris Binocular 1531 Night Vision Goggles – \$199,999.95. Purchase of 23 L3 Harris Binocular 1531 Night Vision goggle system kits for Special Weapons and Tactics Team. These devices are necessary to ensure proper visibility when conducting high risk missions and training during low light and no light conditions through the use of dual tube night vision goggles.

L3 Harris NGAL Infrared Illuminator and Designators – \$130,000. Purchase of 50 L3 Harris NGAL Infrared Illuminator and Designators for Special Weapons and Tactics Team. These devices are necessary to ensure proper visibility when conducting high risk missions and training during low light and no light conditions through the use of an infrared illuminator and designator.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend \$199,999.95 for L3 Harris Binocular 1531 Night Vision Goggles and \$130,000.00 for L3 Harris NGAL Infrared Illuminator and Designators from the FY 2022 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-Federal Forfeitures.
