Consideration: A request to change the zoning designation from A-1 (Citrus Rural District) to C-1 Restricted (Retail Commercial District) in order to allow for a Dance Studio and Martial Arts School only; pursuant to Part II, Chapter 163, Florida Statutes and Orange County Code Chapter 30 **Location:** District 1; property located at 2220 Hempel Avenue; generally on the west side of Hempel Avenue, approximately 500 feet south of Lake Hugh Drive; Orange County, Florida (legal property description on file in Planning Division)
