Adoption of Future Land Use Map Amendment SS-22-06-058, Ordinance, and Concurrent Rezoning RZ-22-06-059, Joseph Bricklemyer, P.A.

c. Rezoning RZ-22-06-059

Consideration: A request to change the zoning designation from R-1A (Single-Family Dwelling District) and C-2 (General Commercial District) to C-2 Restricted (General Commercial District); pursuant to Part II, Chapter 163, Florida Statutes and Orange County Code Chapter 30 Location: District 6; property located at 15 Quintard Avenue; generally located north of Old Winter Garden Road, and east of Quintard Avenue; Orange County, Florida (legal property description on file in Planning Division)

Modified Condition of Approval # 2:

2. A Type B landscape opaque buffer, consisting of vegetation and a darker vinyl fence 6 foot in height, shall be provided and maintained along the northern property line, consistent with the requirements of Section 24-5 of the Orange County Code.

A motion was made by Commissioner Siplin, seconded by Commissioner Gomez Codero, to make a finding of consistency with the Comprehensive Plan; further, adopt Amendment SS-22-06-058, Commercial (C) Future Land Use; further, adopt the associated Small-Scale Ordinance 2022-35; further, approve the concurrent rezoning request from R-1A (Single-Family Dwelling District) and C-2 (General Commercial District) to C-2 Restricted (General Commercial District) subject to the five (5) restrictions listed in the Staff Report dated September 6, 2022; and further, approve modified condition of approval # 2.
