SUBJECT: Approval of Contract Y23-2046, Innovation Programming for Youth District  
6

### ACTION REQUESTED:

Approval of Contract Y23-2046, Innovation Programming for Youth District 6, with Capoeira for Tomorrow, Inc. in the contract award amount of \$200,000 for a two-year term.

### PURPOSE:

This contract will provide funds to support Innovation Programming for Youth District 6 in which Capoeira for Tomorrow, Inc. has identified an issue affecting youth, developed a potential solution, and will implement a creative strategy that will effect change. The performance period will be January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2024.

### FUNDING:

Funding is available in account number 0001-062-2556-8610.

### APPROVALS:

The Citizens' Review Panel for Human Services (CRP) recommended Capoeira for Tomorrow, Inc. to receive CRP funding to provide Innovation Programming for Youth District 6. The Citizens' Commission for Children Division concurs with the funding recommendation.

### REMARKS:

In accordance with the Code of Ordinances, Part 1, Chapter 17, Article III, Section 17-286 – Application and Exclusions, agreements between the Board and nonprofit organizations are excluded from competitive procurement requirements.

Capoeira for Tomorrow, Inc. will provide Innovation Programming for Youth District 6 to students enrolled in Florida Virtual School Flex and supplement the educational curriculum with courses relating to developing a growth mindset, managing thoughts and emotions, reframing failure, navigating judgment and peer pressure, living confidently and compassionately, making and managing money, expression through art, unleashing power from within, and the importance of self-love.
