The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$32,500 from the FY 2023 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-Federal Treasury Forfeitures for the following purpose:

Equipment:

L3 Harris NGAL Infrared Illuminator and Designators – \$32,500. The Orange County Sheriff's Office SWAT Team was previously awarded approval to purchase 50 L3 Harris NGAL infrared illuminator devices at the cost of \$130,000. Since the time of submission and Board approval on September 27, 2022, L3 Harris increased the price by \$32,500.

ACTION REQUESTED: Approval for the Orange County Sheriff's Office to spend an additional \$32,500 for L3 Harris NGAL Infrared Illuminator and Designators from the FY 2023 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-Federal Treasury Forfeitures.

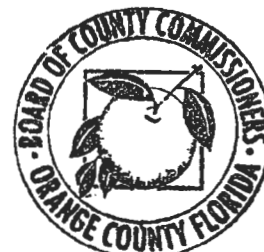
