SUBJ: Approval to Decrease the Speed Limit on Edgewater Drive

Concerned citizens have requested Orange County to review the posted speed along Edgewater Drive from Rose Avenue to Forest City Road. They expressed that the posted speed is too high and presents a safety risk.

Vehicular/pedestrian safety and recent accident statistics were the primary considerations for a speed reduction analysis along the Edgewater Drive corridor. Based on the results from the prevailing speed method (including allowable adjustments) and USLIMITS2 analysis, it is recommended that the speed limit of 40 mph be reduced to 35 mph on the 2-lane segment (Rose Avenue to Clarcona Ocoee Road) and the 4-lane segment (Clarcona Ocoee Road to Forest City Road) remain at 40 mph.

Action Requested: Approval to decrease the speed limit on Edgewater Drive from Rose Avenue to Clarcona Ocoee Road from 40 mph to 35 mph. District 2.


