RECOMMENDATION:

Selection of one firm and an alternate to provide Continuing Professional Services for Water Resources Program, Request for Proposals Y22-906-ZR, from the following firms listed alphabetically.

Arcadis U.S., Inc.

• Carollo Engineers, Inc.

Request the Board to authorize execution of the final contract by the Procurement Division to establish hourly rates for future requirements for an initial three-year term with two one-year renewals. Further request authorization for the Procurement Division to formally terminate negotiations with the top ranked firm, if we are unable to come to a favorable negotiated agreement, and commence negotiations with the next ranked alternate.

The Procurement Committee evaluated the proposals on December 14, 2022. Commissioner Emily Bonilla was assigned to the Procurement Committee.

PURPOSE:

This contract will provide continuing professional services water resources program for water, wastewater and reclaimed water systems to the Utilities Department. Services under this contract will include study, planning, permitting, ground and surface water modeling, water resources program management, geographic information system and hydraulic modeling, design related to permitting, construction administration, utility master planning, and capital improvement program project management as needed.

DISCUSSION:

Two proposals were received in response to this Request for Proposals (RFP). The Procurement Committee evaluated the proposals in accordance with the criteria set forth in the RFP.
