This amendment is necessary to provide an additional \$83,108 this fiscal year that will be used to hire and employ a Housing Staff Attorney to support the County's Office of Tenant Services.

AMENDMENT NO. 1 SERVICE FUNDING AGREEMENT FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023

This first amendment ("Amendment") is entered into by and between <u>Orange County</u>, <u>Florida</u> (the "County") and <u>Legal Aid Society of the Orange County Bar Association</u>, <u>Inc.</u> ("Legal Aid" or "Agency"). The County and Agency may be referred to individually as "Party" or collectively as "Parties". The purpose of this Amendment is to alter the terms of the Service Funding Agreement for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 that was approved by the Orange County Board of County Commissioners on October 11, 2022 ("Agreement"). The Parties desire to increase the amount of funding that the County provides to the Agency to employ one (1) additional, experienced staff attorney to provide housing litigation services to the community including, but not limited to, those persons referred to the Agency by the County's Office of Tenant Services.

<u>Section 1.</u> Amendments to Section 2. Section 2, Subsection d. on Page 2 of the Agreement is hereby amended as follows with additions shown as <u>underlines</u> and deletions shown as <u>strikethroughs</u>:

SECTION 2. THE LEGAL AID SOCIETY SHALL

* * *

- d. Employ the necessary professional, clerical staff, and volunteers to ensure efficient operations and the ability to offer the services outlined in section 3a.
 - i. The Legal Aid Society shall hire and employ a minimum of one (1) additional, experienced staff attorney to provide housing litigation services as further described in this Agreement and the *Job Description* attached to this Agreement as Exhibit B ("Housing Staff Attorney").
 - ii. The Legal Aid Society shall accept referrals for legal services from the County and the County's Office of Tenant Services. The Legal Aid Society shall utilize the Housing Staff Attorney to provide legal services to persons referred to the Legal Aid Society by the County's Office of Tenant Services."

<u>Section 2.</u> Amendments to Section 3. Section 3, Subsection a. on Page 3 of the Agreement is hereby amended as follows with additions shown as <u>underlines</u> and deletions shown as <u>strikethroughs</u>:

"SECTION 3. FUNDING MECHANICS

a. The County agrees to appropriate a total amount not to exceed one million four hundred fourteen thousand two hundred thirty-six dollars (\$1,414,236) one million two hundred sixty-seven thousand seventeen dollars (\$1,331,128) to the Legal Aid Society of the Orange County Bar Association, Inc., for fiscal year 2022-2023 for the provision of legal aid services in accordance with Section 29.008, Florida Statutes, and the terms of this Agreement ("Funds"). according to Florida Statute 29.008. This amount includes \$106,485 for support of Guardian ad Litem.

- i. The Legal Aid Society shall use a portion of the Funds to support Guardian ad Litem Services. The Parties estimate that approximately one hundred six thousand four hundred eighty-five dollars (\$106,485) of the Funds will be used to support Guardian ad Litem services.
- ii. The Legal Aid Society shall use a portion of the Funds to hire and employ a Housing Staff Attorney for the provision of services described in Section 2 of this Agreement. The Parties estimate that approximately eighty-three thousand one hundred eight dollars (\$83,108) of the Funds will be used to hire and employ the Housing Staff Attorney in accordance with the Staff Attorney Budget attached to this Agreement as Exhibit C."

<u>Section 3.</u> Attachments. The *Job Description* attached to this Amendment as Exhibit B and the *Staff Attorney Budget* attached to this Amendment as Exhibit C are hereby incorporated into the Agreement and attached to the Agreement as Exhibit B and Exhibit C, respectively.

<u>Section 4.</u> Right to <u>Deny.</u> If the services rendered by the Agency do not comply with this Amendment, then the County reserves the right to deny payment or any requests for payment or reimbursement from the Agency.

Section 5. Effective Date: Conflicts; Full Force. This Amendment is hereby made a part of the Agreement and shall be effective upon execution by both parties (the "Effective Date"). All provisions in the Agreement, any attachments to the Agreement, or any previous amendments that conflict with this Amendment are hereby changed to conform to this Amendment. Except as expressly modified in this Amendment or in any previous amendment to the Agreement, the Agreement remains intact, unchanged, and in full force and effect.
