The Orange County Sheriff's Office is requesting \$5,000 from the FY 2023 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-State Forfeitures for the following purposes:

National Alliance on Mental Illness of Greater Orlando (NAMIGO) – **\$2,500.** This contribution will provide funding in support of the 2023 Annual NAMIWalks annual fundraiser on Saturday, April 22, 2023, at Cranes Roost Park in Altamonte Springs. NAMIGO is a partner of local law enforcement agencies in educating first responders in the appropriate skills of dealing with those who suffer a mental illness.

Autism Society of Greater Orlando - \$2,500. This contribution will provide individuals with the autism spectrum a network of opportunities to become fully accepted and actively participating members of the community. The Autism Society of Greater Orlando will be hosting its 18th Annual Autism Family Fun Day on April 8, 2023 at the Orange County Convention Center.


