- SUBJECT: Consent Agenda Item March 5, 2024 Orange County Head Start Eligibility Priority Selection Criteria for 2024-2025. All Districts

The Head Start Division requests Board approval of Orange County Head Start Eligibility Priority Selection Criteria for 2024-2025. The eligibility priority selection criteria is required to establish a formal selection process, as mandated by the Improving Head Start for School Readiness Act of 2007 and Head Start Program Performance Standard 1302.14 which indicates that a program must annually establish selection criteria that weigh the prioritization of selection of participants, based on community needs identified in the community needs assessment as described in §1302.11 (b).

The eligibility priority selection criteria is used to determine the selection of eligible children for the Head Start Program. The eligibility priority selection criteria was approved by the Head Start Policy Council on February 15, 2024.

#### **ACTION REQUESTED:**

Approval of Orange County Head Start Eligibility Priority Selection Criteria for 2024-2025 to establish a formal selection process for eligible children and families. All Districts.
