

SUBJ: **Construction of Speed Humps on Lilwill Avenue**

At the request of the residents on Lilwill Avenue, a speed hump survey was mailed to the property owners. This was to determine if the property owners supported the installation of speed humps on Lilwill Avenue. If two-thirds of the returned ballots from the property owners were in favor of the speed humps, the County would install the speed humps.

The result of the survey was that 100% of the returned ballots from property owners supported the installation of speed humps. The current plan is to install two speed humps on Lilwill Avenue. The project is being funded by Commission District 6 and Public Works.



# Lilwill Avenue Consent Agenda District Map
